

## GROUNDWORK 2010:

We are currently seeking proposals from BC dance artists for regional touring activities to take place in 2011/12.

Made in BC – Dance on Tour was created to increase touring opportunities for BC contemporary dance artists throughout the province. We also work closely with a presenter network to promote contemporary dance in regional communities through local dance outreach activities.

Put simply, we're about getting dance out there – and getting more people to engage with it.

Since 2006/07, we have worked with 10 communities around the province: Courtenay, Kelowna, Kitimat, Nanaimo, Nelson, Prince Rupert, Salt Spring Island, Smithers, Terrace, and +Vernon.

### How to submit a proposal

This year's submission process has 3 steps:

1. **Letter of intent** (see sidebar for instructions)
  - **MUST be submitted prior to completing application.**
  - **Deadline: Friday, November 20, 2009**
2. (Optional) **Information Session: Monday, November 23, 2009**
3. **Application form** (will be available at [www.madeinbc.org](http://www.madeinbc.org))
  - **Deadline: Monday, December 7, 2009.**

### Why we're asking for a letter of intent

Basically, we would like more interaction with our applicants. Having an idea of who will be applying, and what projects will be coming forward will help us plan appropriate information sessions and resource workshops.

### What happens after applications are submitted in December

All applications, including related materials, are compiled and distributed to the Made in BC presenter network, who will shortlist applicants. Profiles of shortlisted applicants will appear on the Made in BC website, and will be invited to a Pitch Session on **Wednesday, March 24, 2010.**

All applicants **MUST** submit a letter of intent before applications will be accepted. Please limit your letter to 1 page, and include the following information:

1. **Name / Title / Contact Details.**

2. **\*Company name.**

3. **Project Name & brief description.** Include date & location the piece(s) premiered.

If you have applied to Groundwork before, that is all the information we need.

If you have *not* applied to Groundwork before, please also include:

4. **Brief Company profile.**

5. **Brief statement explaining why you would like to tour the Made in BC network.**
